## #7 District nursing is too easy or too boring

District nursing is complex. A typical day involves a variety of nursing duties in people's homes, including medication administration, bowel care, complex wound care, IV care, palliative care, health promotion and much more. The district nursing service runs a variety of nurse-led clinics, for example caring for leg ulcers and specialising in Doppler assessments. The job also includes liaising with members of the multi-disciplinary team, integrated working with therapists, specialist nurses and social service staff, and also teaching and mentoring students, both pre and post registration.
