## 'My proudest moment in nursing in the last year'

'My proudest moment over the past year is that I was redeployed to be the Clinical Lead at a large Covid-19 Vaccination Centre. Between 25<sup>th</sup> January 2021 and 4<sup>th</sup> March 2022 we vaccinated 149,733 individuals over the age of 16 at the centre. I could not have done any of this without the support from a fantastic ops team, the help and support from volunteers who have given up so much of their free time so as to make a difference as well as the support from my nursing colleagues, many of whom retired and returned to join the temporary covid-19 register and to people from all walks of life who have trained to be vaccinators. Every day I am humbled by the support from the team here. We even had a visit from the Prime Minister in March 2021. The ability to be Clinical Lead has allowed me to use all my clinical skills (my substantive post is a Medicines Optimisation Nurse Consultant & NMP Lead) and I couldn't think of a better team to end my career in, I have been a nurse for 38 years and I would do it again in a flash if I could.'
